register for prizes and contest. They can easily do this online or by phone.

No one over the age of 16 will be allowed on the field to ensure the safety of all our children. Toddler time will be in a smaller confined area.

In addition to the main event, face painting, special entertainment our Mrs. Easter Bunny will wander around making herself also available for photos with the kids!

The annual event is free and everyone is welcome. Children are asked to bring their Easter Basket or a bag to use while collecting their eggs and parents bring your own cameras for the many photo opportunities.
